

# DEFAULT SERVICE

Transportation customers without a capacity assignment rely on their marketer's capacity and not NEGC's capacity to deliver gas to the NEGC system; thus, NEGC has decided that customers utilizing their marketer's capacity are not eligible to return to sales service because returning customers would not have the necessary pipeline capacity and gas supplies to service them. Instead, NEGC has developed a new service, called Default Service, through an arrangement with a third party supplier to meet the sales requirements of customers without NEGC capacity. Default service allows customers who leave their current marketer to continue transporting until such time that they enter into a contract with a new marketer.

Default Transportation Service is available as follows:

## Short Notice Default Service

Available to customers with an immediate need for a new marketer upon twenty-four (24) hour notice by the customer to NEGC. See attached pricing information.

## Advance Notice Default Service

Available to customers who have advance knowledge of a change in their marketer and who are unable to contract with a new marketer before their existing supply contract is terminated. This service requires notice from the customer to NEGC no less than three (3) business days before the start of the calendar month.
