TSS**

**The Transitional Sales Service (TSS) tariff provides a framework for accommodating customer migration from transportation service to firm-sales service that protects the interest of existing sales service customers. The TSS tariff formalizes an approach and methodology for calculating and charging the migrating customers market based gas prices at the time gas is consumed rather than using prices for natural gas previously purchased over an extended period of time on behalf of sales customers. Each month, the market based price is compared with the price the Company's previously committed purchases and any applicable surcharge is posted to the Company's website.**

**TSS is applicable to customers (a) who terminate supplier service, (b) who receive a termination notice from a designated supplier, or (c) for whom a designated supplier becomes ineligible to serve the customer.**

**The provisions of this rate schedule are in addition to the provisions of the Company's applicable firm sales service rate schedules. Details can be found in the Company's Tariff RIPUC NEGC No. 101 under Section 5, Commercial and Industrial Services, Schedule H.**
