Retirement of the Monroe HVDC Converter Terminal

Effective March 31, 2007 at 23:59, the Monroe HVDC Converter Terminal in Monroe, New Hampshire, (known as part of Phase I), will cease commercial operations. Any power transit through the facility will end at that time.

The station will continue to provide 230KV AC voltage support until an alternative means has been installed and commissioned. All Phase II equipment located at the Monroe Terminal will continue to be powered and supported until the equipment has been either relocated or decommissioned as determined by joint NEH/HQ studies.
