National Grid would like to thank you for participating in National Grid's "LED Eligible Products List." Together we have completed many successful projects and our customers are achieving some terrific energy savings. However, this list was always considered to be a temporary measure until the Energy Star and Design Lights Consortium (DLC) lists became more robust. We feel that both parties are making great strides to include additional products as more manufacturers are meeting their testing requirements. **Therefore, our list will be closed to new products on December 31, 2010.**

All products after this date must be submitted to the appropriate entity. Energy Star will cover products such as integral lamps, bollards and recessed lighting while the DLC will review garage/canopy luminaires, wall packs, street and area lighting, track heads, and case refrigeration. (This list of product types is not meant to be exhaustive, if you have question as to where your product needs to be submitted please contact Energy Star or the DLC.)

All products on the list as of December 31, 2010 **will continue to be eligible for incentives from National Grid**, regardless of whether or not they are on the Energy Star or DLC lists for an undetermined period of time. **After December 31, 2010 any new products must be submitted through either Energy Star or DLC to qualify for incentives from National Grid.**
