Grandfathering Policy for Mass Save Interim LED List

All products on the list as of December 31, 2010 **will continue to be eligible for incentives from Mass Save program administrators**, regardless of whether or not they are on the Energy Star or Design Lights Consortium (DLC) lists for an undetermined period of time.

After December 31, 2010 any new products must be submitted to Energy Star or DLC to qualify for incentives from Mass Save program administrators. Energy Star will cover products such as integral lamps, bollards, and recessed lighting while the DLC will review garage/canopy luminaires, wall packs, street and area lighting, track heads, and case refrigeration. (This list of product types is not meant to be exhaustive, if you questions as to where your product information needs to be submitted please contact Energy Star or DLC.)
