

Transitional Sales Service (TSS)

The Transitional Sales Service (TSS) tariff provides a framework for accommodating customer migration from transportation service to firm-sales service that protects the interest of existing sales service customers. The TSS tariff formalizes an approach and methodology for calculating and charging the migrating customers market based gas prices at the time gas is consumed rather than using prices for natural gas previously purchased over an extended period of time on behalf of sales customers. A copy of the tariff with all applicable provisions can be found in the Company’s Tariff RIPUC NGRID No. 101 under Section 5, Commercial and Industrial Services, Schedule H.

The TSS surcharge as of the 1st of each month is shown on the following table. Note that the actual charge appearing on any customer’s bill will be prorated based on the billing days in each month, e.g. a 30 day billing period billed on the 10th of a month will reflect 10 days at the current month’s surcharge and 20 days at the prior month’s surcharge.
