

Wakefield to Lynn Transmission Project

(A179/Q169 Transmission Lines)

Project Overview:

The Wakefield to Lynn Transmission Project will upgrade National Grid structures that make up the A179 and Q169 transmission lines. These lines go through Wakefield, Saugus, Revere, and Lynn.

The project is roughly 15 miles and will be completed in two phases:

- Phase 1: A179 line from Revere to Lynn
- Phase 2: Q169 line from Wakefield to Saugus then Lynn

The primary purpose of the project is to upgrade existing structures in the A179/Q169 line to maintain reliability.

What to expect during construction:

Construction will primarily occur within National Grid's right of way. Residents should expect increased activities within the right of way. A full map of the project line can be found on the second page.

General construction activities include:

- Site preparation and vegetation trimming/removal
- Replacing wood structures with new steel structures
- Work pad installation
- No planned interruption to service for National Grid customers

Safety Information:
