

We are upgrading infrastructure to provide better service to your community.

Dear Neighbor:

Beginning in April 2026, National Grid will be replacing existing gas infrastructure in Albany on Central Avenue between North Allen Street and Henry Johnson Boulevard. This work is being done to continue providing safe and reliable gas service to customers. Work hours are generally Monday to Friday, 7 A.M. to 5:30 P.M., and we anticipate completing this work in Fall 2026. Please note that timelines may change due to weather or operational requirements.

As part of this work, there will be service transfers and interruptions. Our contractors will be reaching out to you to schedule a time for the service transfer.

Phase 1:

- Work between Henry Johnson Blvd. and North Lake Ave. will consist of a gas main install and service transfers to businesses.

Phase 2:

- Work between North Lake Ave. to Manning Blvd. will consist of a gas main install and service transfers to businesses.

Phase 3:

- Work between Manning Blvd. and North Allen St. will consist of service transfers to businesses.
