National Grid is writing to notify you of plans to perform a project in your neighborhood. This project will be taking place on Ridge Road and Dutch Broadway, right in front of Elmont Memorial Junior-Senior High School. The project will improve and modernize the existing Regulator Station on Dutch Broadway. Construction is scheduled to begin approximately in May, 2022. Date: To begin May, 2022.

Completion time: August, 2022.

Construction days and hours: Day hours: 7 AM to 4 PM (occasional non-weekday work may be required).

Where: On Ridge Road and Dutch Broadway, Elmont NY

What you can expect during construction.

Typical natural gas work includes:

- Marking out underground utilities within the project scope area (e.g., water, sewer, gas, electric, etc.).
- Excavation of the street and/or sidewalk and laying of new gas route.
- Temporary disruption of street parking.
- Temporary and then permanent restoration of disturbed areas in accordance with DOT specifications.

Traffic: Will be open but modified during construction hours. A traffic flagger will be on-site during work hours to safely direct vehicles.

Please know National Grid and its contractors will remain vigilant by continuing to adhere to all COVID-19 safety guidelines set by the CDC, New York State, and our local permitting authorities, protecting our employees, customers and the public. When construction is done for the day the site will be secured and plated. A pedestrian walkway will be available for students drop-off on the west side of Ridge road.
