Planned Outage in Raquette Lake

Work at NYSEG's station is nearing completion and as a result, we need to schedule a three-hour outage on Wednesday, July 30 from approximately 9 a.m. to Noon on the distribution feeder line, indicated in yellow on the map below, to support NYSEG's station commissioning. In the event of inclement weather, our rain date is Thursday, July 31.
