

Hampton Bays: Update on current work in your neighborhood

Dear Neighbor:

We wanted to share an update on the current work in your neighborhood. This winter we began installing an upgraded regulator station and retiring an existing regulator station on Old Riverhead Rd. and Montauk Highway.

The project will have intermittent schedules: Work will be completed in the daytime hours during non-summer months (from February until Memorial Day and resuming after Labor Day). During the summer months we will have a lighter crew performing less impactful work and less presence at the site to meet project completion schedule. Additional work complete during the summer (from Memorial Day through Labor Day) may be completed at night to lessen impact to traffic, only if required.

Project details:

This project will increase system integrity throughout your neighborhood, increase reliability of service.

Projected construction start: January 2022

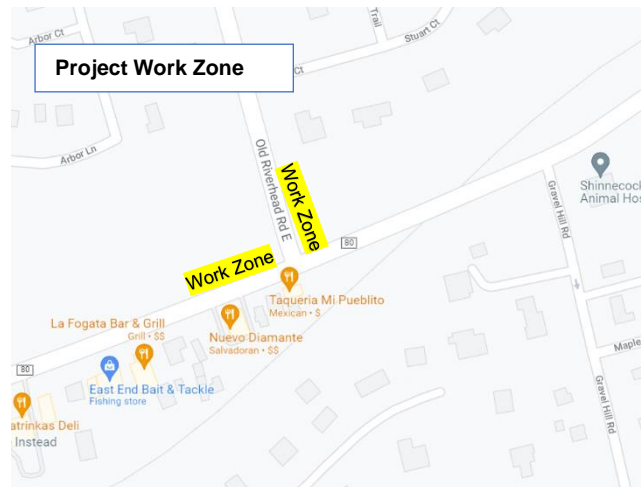
Projected construction finish: Spring 2023

Where: East Montauk Highway and Old Riverhead Rd., Hampton Bays

** Schedule is subject to change due to weather. Work will take place Monday through Friday. Additional work on Saturday(s) may be necessary* **Construction activities will be lightened from Memorial Day through Labor Day to assist in traffic.***

What to expect during construction:

- Traffic will remain open on Montauk Highway.
- There will be no parking on Montauk Highway near work zones.
- Marking out underground utilities within the project area (e.g., water, sewer, gas, electric, etc.).
- For your safety, please do not enter work zones and be mindful of work zones during and after construction hours.
- **Temporary and then permanent restoration** of disturbed areas will be done in accordance with Suffolk County DPW and Town of Southampton specifications.
- We will be temporarily restoring the work area throughout the coming months. Please note, this is not final restoration. The restoration you will see during the summer and fall months are not final, but the temporary restoration of the first phase of this project. We will complete final restoration of the entire area once the project is fully complete in the spring of 2023.
