**Energy Affordability Program**

Customers who apply for and receive HEAP receive an automatic credit on their bill through EAP. You may also qualify if you receive:

- Medicaid
- Child Health Plus
- Food Stamps (SNAP)
- Safety Net Assistance
- Supplemental Security Income (SSI)
- Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (Family Assistance)
- Veteran's Disability Pension
- Veteran's Surviving Spouse Pension

**Winter safety check list**



Install carbon monoxide (CO) alarms on each level of your home. CO poisoning is more prevalent in winter.



Know the signs of CO poisoning: flu-like symptoms, headache, dizziness, weakness, sleepiness, nausea, chest tightness.



Carefully and regularly remove snow and clear icicles from overhangs near meter and pipes.



## Alarms add safety and protection year round

Detectors keep you safe. It's important to note the differences:

- A smoke alarm senses smoke indicating a fire.
- A carbon monoxide detector sounds when CO is present.
- A residential methane detector (RMD) signals when methane is in the air, a sign of a gas leak.

Follow manufacturer's instructions for installation and proper placement.
