Use your backup generator safely.

While a backup generator can keep equipment and appliances running in the event of a power outage, it's important to operate it safely.

- Always consult with a qualified electrician before installing a generator.
- Never plug a generator directly into a wall outlet.
- Ensure that your generator has a transfer switch.
- Never install/operate a generator inside or near open windows or doors.





Never hang items from gas pipes. Doing so can weaken pipes, creating a hazard.



Designate a relative, trusted friend or an agency to receive copies of notices should your account become overdue.

Home Energy Assistance Program (HEAP)

HEAP assists income-eligible customers with winter heating bills. Emergency HEAP opens Jan. 2 to income eligible households with a heating emergency (utility shut off notice required). HEAP also has a Heating Equipment Clean and Tune and a Heating Equipment Repair and Replacement programs. These programs are designed to help eligible customers keep their heating systems maintained. Energy Affordability Program (EAP)

Customers who apply for and receive HEAP are automatically enrolled and will get a monthly bill credit. Visit **ngrid.com/discount** and select "Monthly Bill Credit - Energy Affordability Program" for more information.

Improve your heating system's performance.

With a few simple steps you can improve your heating system's efficiency:

- Clear areas in front of vents.
- Use programmable thermostats to lower the temperature.
- Change your furnace filter regularly.



Carbon monoxide and methane detectors.

Two types of detectors can help you stay safe year-round. Carbon monoxide detectors sound the alarm when colorless, odorless CO is present. A residential methane detector signals when methane is in the air, a sign of a natural gas leak.
