Please contact us if you suspect a shared meter. A shared meter is illegal and building owners can incur large fines. Tenants should only pay for the gas or electricity that is provided to their dwelling or areas under their control.

### Prevent carbon monoxide poisoning.

- Schedule a heating system checkup.
- Install carbon monoxide detectors on every level of your home and ensure they're working properly.

If your detector goes off, get everyone outside immediately and call **911** or **1-800-892-2345**.
