WINTER RELIEF RECOVERY PROVISION

1. Purpose

This Winter Relief Recovery (“WRR”) Provision provides for the recovery of deferred costs associated with reduction of billed residential customer charges funded by Massachusetts Electric Company and Nantucket Electric Company, d/b/a National Grid (collectively “National Grid” or the “Company”) and approved by the Department of Public Utilities (the “Department”). Pursuant to the Department’s approval in D.P.U. 26-11, the Company issued a 25 percent reduction of billed charges associated with customer usage in February and March 2026 to its residential customers, a portion of which was funded by proceeds from the Commonwealth. The total bill reductions provided, less amounts funded by the Commonwealth, were approved to be deferred for future recovery through separate factors.

2. Applicability

The Company’s residential rates for Retail Delivery Service are subject to adjustment to reflect the operation of this WRR Provision. Any reduction of billed charges funded by the Company will be deferred and collected from residential customers through the Winter Relief Recovery Factors (“WRRF”), as defined herein, and shall be applied to all retail delivery service kilowatt-hours (“kWhs”) of residential customers in accordance with Section 4.0 below.

This provision is applicable to the residential Retail Delivery Service tariffs of the Company. The operation of this WRR Provision is subject to Chapter 164 of the General Laws.

3. Effective Date

The WRRFs, as defined below, shall be effective for usage on and after May 1, 2026 through December 31, 2026.

4. Winter Relief Recovery Factor (“WRRF”) Formula

$$\text{Winter Relief Recovery Factor}_r = (\text{Winter Relief}_r + \text{RA}) \div \text{FkWhr}$$

where

Winter Relief_r = The deferred 25 percent reduction of billed charges applicable to the Company’s Residential Rate Classes R-1 and R-2 effective for usage billed during the period February 1, 2026 through March 31, 2026, less any amounts funded by the Commonwealth.

RA = The Reconciliation Adjustment shall be the difference between the amount authorized by the Department for recovery through the WRRFs and the actual revenue billed through the WRRFs for the recovery period. Reconciliations shall be performed annually, and interest shall be calculated on the average monthly reconciling balance using the same rate as that paid on customer deposits and added to the reconciling balance.

FkWhr = Forecast Residential kWh deliveries for May through December 2026.

r = Residential Rate Class.

For billing purposes, the WRRF will be included in the Distribution Charge line item on residential customers' bills.

Any residual balance remaining after application of the WRRF shall be charged or credited to residential customers through the Company's Revenue Decoupling Mechanism Reconciliation.
