STORM PERFORMANCE PROVISION

The Company's rates for Retail Delivery Service are subject to adjustment to reflect the credit to customers the following penalties assessed by the Department of Public Utilities resulting from its investigation of the Company's performance in responding to major weather events: \$18,725,000 in D.P.U. 11-85-A/11-119-A credited in March 2013; and \$750,000 in D.P.U. 18-02 credited in May 2019.

For billing purposes, the Storm Performance credit will be identified separately on customers' bills and will take the form of a one-time per billing account credit, subject to review and approval by the Department.

Any residual balance remaining after application of the credit shall be credited or charged to the Company's storm fund balance.

In the event that the Department's decision to impose the penalties is reversed or modified as the result of an appeal, the Company shall recover the amount of the reduction through a one-time per billing account charge, or in such other manner as approved by the Department.

This provision is applicable to all Retail Delivery Service tariffs of the Company. The operation of this Storm Performance Provision is subject to Chapter 164 of the General Laws.
