ALC installers improve thermal comfort and energy efficiency in homes through the proper installation of insulation materials and air sealing measures. Their work results in improved comfort for occupants and energy cost savings, too.

Steps to earning BPI's Air Leakage Control Certification.

- 2 Get matched with a participating training location.
- 3 Earn the Building Science Principles Certificate of Knowledge.
- 4 Get expert training for the ALC certification exam.
- 5 Challenge the ALC exam.

BPI Air Leakage Control (ALC) professionals must recertify every three years.

Candidates that meet specific work experience criteria during their certification period may be able to bypass the recertification exam.
