Saving energy is even more rewarding when you curtail electricity use during demand response events.

INCENTIVE PAYMENT \$35 per kW per year

For example, if you curtailed an average of **100 kW** of electricity over a summer, the incentive National Grid would make available would be:

$$100kW \times \frac{\$35}{kW} = \$3,500 \text{ every year}$$

National Grid will pay this incentive directly to your selected Curtailment Service Provider. How much of this incentive is passed down to the customer depends on the negotiations between the customer and the Curtailment Service Provider.

Eligibility Requirements

- Must be a National Grid electric customer in Massachusetts or Rhode Island.
- Must be on a G-2 or G-3 rate in MA, or a G-02 or G-32 rate in Rhode Island.
- Must enroll before May 31st of any given year to participate in that year's demand response program.
- After your business signs up for the program, it will remain in the program until it unsubscribes.
- Must participate through an approved curtailment service provider.

About Demand Response Events

- Events will be called the day before curtailment is needed.
- A maximum of 20 hours of events will be called per summer.
- All events will start at 2pm and end at 5pm.
- All events will be called in June, July, August, and September.
- If a customer is called to curtail due to their enrollment in ISO-NE's markets on an event day, National Grid will not require that customer to curtail for that day.

About the Incentive

- Incentives will be paid out in October of each year.
- Incentives will be based on the average performed curtailment amount for all events.

Details about the Demand Response Incentive Program

- This program is part of a 2-year demonstration project for demand response. National Grid cannot guarantee that incentives will be available after the summer of 2018.
- Incentives are limited to the first 60MW of demand response assets to register.

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
