

Overview:

To receive incentives in the EV Charging Station Make-Ready Program, Electric Vehicle Supply Equipment (EVSE) must meet the following requirements:

- All projects receiving Project Application Approvals after December 15, 2023 shall be hardware capable for ISO 15118 Parts 2 and 20
- Requirements for software capability for ISO 15118 Parts 2 and 20 and hardware capability for OCPP 2.0.1 are **on hold** pending a ruling from the Public Service Commission on the Joint Utilities' March 15, 2024 <u>Petition Requesting Changes to the Make-Ready Order Requirements</u>
- All projects with Level 2 EVSE must meet ENERGY STAR® Specification for Electric Vehicle Supply Equipment April 2017 V1.0 or V1.2
