

LIGHTING UPGRADES: Incentives are ending this year. **ACT NOW!**

Start your LED lighting projects before the incentives get turned off.

In accordance with a directive from the New York State Public Service Commission, utility programs throughout the state are required to phase out lighting incentives by Dec. 31, 2025. So, don't wait too long, or you could miss out on substantial incentives, as well as ongoing monthly energy savings for your business.

Ensure your project is completed on time to qualify for the final lighting incentives.

BY DEC. 31, 2025

- **Return the signed and dated customer report.***

BY OCT. 31, 2026

- **The project must be completed.****

BY DEC. 15, 2026

- **The project must be paid.*****

Why upgrade your lighting now?

By replacing your existing lighting with energy-efficient solutions now, you'll maximize your incentives to achieve lower energy use and maintenance, higher safety and comfort, and improved sustainability.

* Returning the signed customer report confirms the customer's intent to move forward and install the project in accordance with scope laid out in the customer report. and meet the deadlines for an incentive payment.

** Project completion is defined as the installation and measures being operational that are included in the scope, along with returning final signatures to National Grid. Failure to receive the final signatures confirming project completion and operation by Oct. 31, 2026, may result in the incentive not being paid. Partial rebates will be considered for what is completed by Oct. 31, 2026. If these deadlines are not met, National Grid will not be able to issue an incentive.

***To have a project paid, National Grid must receive final signatures, final paid invoices for labor and materials, and a completed post-inspection, if required, to verify that the equipment is installed and operational. If all of this data is not complete, the incentive will not be paid. The total incentive amount with the bonus applied cannot exceed 100% of the cost of the project.
