<sup>2</sup> To be eligible for the rebate payment, equipment must be installed at **11000 Main St, Gloucester, MA 01930** and documentation must be submitted by the Authorization Expiration Date **3/28/2026**. Failure to install all equipment as approved by this date may disqualify or reduce rebate payment. Equipment installation may be subject to an onsite verification and cannot receive an incentive through another Sponsor offering. Rebate not to exceed total project cost. This project must meet eligibility criteria and the Terms & Conditions as listed on the [2025 Commercial Heat Pump Rebate Form](#).

<sup>3</sup> If partially displacing an existing oil, propane, or natural gas heating system, an integrated control model number must be included or must certify that an existing building control system will operate both the heat pump and the existing fossil fuel heating system in parallel. Either control system must prioritize heat pump operation. If installing a dual fuel RTU, manufacturer built in controls may act as the integrated control to enable supplemental heat, eliminating the need for an external control. Confirmation from the manufacturer on the sequence of operations may be requested by the Sponsor.
