

Safety Moment: Sun Protection

1. Understand UV Radiation:

- UV rays are strongest from 10 a.m. to 4 p.m.
- **UVA:** Causes skin aging and cancer.
- UVB: Causes sunburn and contributes to skin cancer.

2. Protective Measures:

- **Wear Sunscreen:** Use broad-spectrum SPF 30 or higher. Reapply every two hours.
- **Dress Appropriately:** Wear long sleeves, long pants, and a wide-brimmed hat.
- Seek Shade: Stay in the shade during peak sun hours.

3.Stay Hydrated:

- Drink plenty of water to prevent dehydration.

4. Recognize Sun Damage:

- Look for signs of sunburn (redness, blistering) and seek medical help if severe.

5.Encourage Dialogue:

- Share tips and remind each other to practice sun safety



Issue Found/Generated

(Found, Sensed, Predictive)

Alert Resolved

(Users informed via Phone, SMS, Email)

Alert Created

(Notifies TDO Vision of issue)

Technician/Asset resolves issue

(TDO Vision detects change in state)

TDO Vision determines how to broadcast alert to selected users

(Phone, SMS, Email, Work Order)

Selected users informed simultaneously


(Eliminates the need of calling/texting/emailing each other)

What Sensors to install if no BMS?

| Sensor Type | • | What It Monitors | Why It's Useful | Example Use Case |
|-----------------|---------------------------------------|-------------------------------------|--|---|
| | Submetering Sensors | Circuit-level energy use | Tracks loads without whole-building metering | HVAC, lighting, plug loads |
| | Temperature & Humidity Sensors | Room comfort and moisture levels | Prevents mold, improves comfort, and detects overheating | Refrigeration, Storage areas, office spaces |
| CO ₂ | CO₂ Sensors | Indoor air quality, occupancy proxy | Optimizes ventilation based on real-time use | Meeting rooms, classrooms |
| | Occupancy Sensors (PIR/Ultrasonic) | Motion or presence | Reduces HVAC and lighting waste | Conference rooms, restrooms |
| | Door/Window Sensors | Open/closed status | Improves HVAC efficiency, security | Exterior doors, windows |
| | Water Leak Sensors | Moisture detection | Prevents costly water damage | Basements, near HVAC units |
