NOTICE OF FIRST STAKEHOLDER MEETING FOR CLCPA STUDY

Dear Secretary Phillips:

Niagara Mohawk Power Corporation d/b/a National Grid (the “Company”) submits this Notice of First Stakeholder Meeting pursuant to the Joint Proposal adopted by the Public Service Commission (“Commission”) on January 20, 2022, in the above-referenced matter in its *Order Adopting Terms of Joint Proposal Establishing Rate Plans and Reporting Requirements*.

The Joint Proposal requires the Company to complete, on or before March 31, 2023, a “CLCPA¹ Study” that evaluates how the Company’s businesses may evolve in the future to support the emission reduction and renewable energy goals of the CLCPA, and any emission reduction goals the Company has independently adopted, and to provide an analysis of the scale, timing, costs, risks, and uncertainties (translated into sensitivity analyses around key cost and availability assumptions), and customer bill impacts of a range of strategies for achieving significant, quantifiable reductions in carbon emissions from the use of gas delivered by the Company in its service territory. Parties to the above-captioned proceeding and other interested stakeholders will have the opportunity to provide input on the scope of the CLCPA Study, to review the draft study, and to provide feedback on the final draft before it is published.

The Company is hereby holding the first stakeholder meeting to receive input from all parties and interested stakeholders on their CLCPA Study Draft Scoping Plan that the Company will file with the Commission in the above-captioned proceeding by **July 8, 2022** and also post on the Company’s website: <https://www.nationalgridus.com/climate-change-study>
