NOTICE OF FILING AND REQUEST FOR COMMENTS

D.P.U. 17-78 March 22, 2017

Petition of Massachusetts Electric Company and Nantucket Electric Company, each d/b/a National Grid, for review and approval of its basic service costs adder rate adjustment for effect May 1, 2017.

On March 15, 2017, Massachusetts Electric Company and Nantucket Electric Company, each d/b/a National Grid ("Company"), filed with the Department of Public Utilities ("Department"), its annual basic service costs adder ("BSCA") rate adjustment and reconciliation filing. The Department docketed this matter as D.P.U. 17-78.

The Company proposes to recover through its BSCA the reconciliation of its electric supply-related costs and revenues from January 2016 through December 2016 and its supply-related forecasted costs from January 2017, through December 2017, which include: (1) cash working capital; (2) bad debt; (3) administration of basic service; (4) conducting the competitive bidding processes; and (5) regulatory compliance.

National Grid proposes the following BSCAs to take effect on May 1, 2017: (1) \$0.00209 per kilowatt-hour ("kWh") for residential customers; (2) \$0.00146 per kWh for commercial customers (rate classes G-1 and streetlighting); and (3) \$0.00073 per kWh for industrial customers (rate classes G-2 and G-3).

If the Company's BSCAs are approved as proposed, the monthly bill for an average basic service residential customer (i.e., a customer using 600 kWh of electricity per month) will decrease by approximately \$2.01, or 1.5 percent, per month. For all other rate classes, the Company states that the impact for customers on basic service will range between decreases of 1.7 percent to 0.3 percent depending on class and usage. For specific bill impacts, please contact the Company as shown below.
