## NOTICE OF FILING AND REQUEST FOR COMMENTS

D.P.U. 17-79 April 28, 2017

Petition by Massachusetts Electric Company and Nantucket Electric Company both d/b/a National Grid for approval of revisions to the termination provision of each Company's Street Lighting Tariffs Rate S-2 and Rate S-3.

On April 10, 2017, Massachusetts Electric Company and Nantucket Electric Company both d/b/a National Grid ("National Grid" or "Company") filed with the Department of Public Utilities ("Department") proposed revisions to the termination provisions of the Company's Street Lighting – Overhead – Customer-owned Equipment S-2 tariff ("Rate S-2") and Street Lighting – Underground – Division of Ownership S-3 tariff ("Rate S-3") to be effective May 1, 2017. The Department has docketed this petition as D.P.U. 17-79, and suspended the operation of the tariffs until June 1, 2017.

The current termination provisions in the Company's Rate S-2 and Rate S-3 require the parties to give six months' prior written notice of the intention to terminate the agreement for lighting service. Approval of the Company's proposed revisions to Rate S-2 and Rate S-3 would change the termination provisions from a minimum of six months prior written notice to a minimum of 45 days prior written notice.
