## SUPPLEMENTAL NOTICE OF FILING AND REQUEST FOR COMMENTS

D.P.U. 19-SQ-05 May 8, 2019

Investigation by the Department of Public Utilities into Boston Gas Company d/b/a National Grid's 2018 Service Quality Report filed pursuant to <u>Service Quality Standards for Electric Distribution Companies and Local Gas Distribution Companies</u>, D.P.U. 12-120-D (2015).

On March 1, 2019, Boston Gas Company d/b/a National Grid ("Company") filed with the Department of Public Utilities ("Department") the Company's 2018 service quality report ("2018 SQ Report") for the period January 1, 2018 through December 31, 2018. The Department docketed the Company's 2018 SQ Report as D.P.U. 19-SQ-05. On March 19, 2019 the Department issued a notice of filing and request for comments ("Notice") in D.P.U. 19-SO-05.

Following the Department's Notice, on April 23, 2019, the Company filed a request that the Department exclude certain data from its 2018 SQ Report ("Waiver Request"). Specifically, the Company requests the Department exclude the 2018 Customer Credit Case metric data from the benchmark calculation for the new metric which will become a penalty measure beginning on January 1, 2019 pursuant to Service Quality Standards for Electric Distribution Companies and Local Gas Distribution Companies, D.P.U. 12-120-D.

The Department will accept written comments on the Company's Waiver Request. Because the Company filed the Waiver Request after the Department issued the Notice, we provide extra time for comment on the Waiver Request. Any person interested in commenting on the Waiver Request may submit written comments no later than the close of business (5:00 p.m.) on **June 7, 2019**. One original and one copy of all written documents must be filed with Mark D. Marini, Secretary, Department of Public Utilities, One South Station, 5th Floor, Boston, Massachusetts 02110. In addition, one copy of all written comments should be sent to the Company's attorney, Andrea Keeffe, Esq., National Grid, 40 Sylvan Road, Waltham, Massachusetts 02451.
