# NOTICE OF FILING AND REQUEST FOR COMMENTS

D.P.U. 25-165 November 13, 2025

Petition of Massachusetts Electric Company and Nantucket Electric Company, each d/b/a National Grid, for approval of its Solar Massachusetts Renewable Target Factor Filing for rates to be effective January 1, 2026.

On November 1, 2024, the Massachusetts Electric Company's and Nantucket Electric Company's, each d/b/a National Grid ("National Grid" or "Company"), filed for approval with the Department of Public Utilities ("Department") its 2026 Solar Massachusetts Renewable Target Factors ("SMART Factors") to be effective January 1, 2026. National Grid states that its filing is consistent with the requirements of Solar Massachusetts Renewable Target Factor Provision, D.P.U. 17-140-A (2018) and its SMART Provision, M.D.P.U. No. 1574. Also, National Grid has filed for approval of a revised SMART Provision, M.D.P.U. No. 1622 that amends M.D.P.U. No. 1574 to update Appendix A to include the Sum of Applicable Distribution, Transmission, Transition, and Three-Year Average of Basic Service Rates for 2026. The Department has docketed this petition as D.P.U. 25-165.

The Company proposes to recover \$130,901,471 through the SMART Factors, calculated as: (1) the sum of (i) estimated annual incentive payments during 2026, (ii) estimated alternative on-bill credits during 2026, (iii) incremental administrative costs during the months October 2024 through September 2025, and (iv) reconciliation of the over/under recovery of costs during the prior year; and (2) minus estimated market revenue during 2026. National Grid's proposed monthly SMART Factors for effect January 1, 2026, are set forth in the following Table on a dollars per kilowatt-hour ("kWh") basis.

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Impacts for residential customers' monthly bill for typical electricity usage are shown on Table 2 below. Customers in each of the General Service and Outdoor Lighting classes should contact the Company directly as shown below for monthly bill impacts.

Any person who desires to participate in the evidentiary phase of this proceeding shall file a petition for leave to intervene no later than 5:00 p.m. on November 24, 2025. A petition for leave to intervene must satisfy the timing and substantive requirements of 220 CMR 1.03. Receipt by the Department, not mailing, constitutes filing and determines whether a petition has been timely filed. A petition filed late may be disallowed as untimely, unless good cause is shown for waiver under 220 CMR 1.01(4). To be allowed, a petition under 220 CMR 1.03(1) must satisfy the standing requirements of G.L. c. 30A, § 10. One copy of any petition to intervene must be emailed to the Company's attorney, Patrick Houghton, Esq. at the email addresses listed above. All responses to petitions to intervene must be filed by the close of business (5:00 p.m.) on the third business day after the petition to intervene was filed.

All documents must also be submitted to the Department in **PDF format** by email attachment to <a href="mailto:dpu.efiling@mass.gov">dpu.efiling@mass.gov</a> and <a href="mailto:timothy.m.federico@mass.gov">timothy.m.federico@mass.gov</a>. The text of the email must specify: (1) the docket number of the proceeding (D.P.U. 25-165); (2) the name of the person or company submitting the filing; and (3) a brief descriptive title of the document. All documents submitted in electronic format will be posted on the Department's website as soon as practicable at <a href="http://www.mass.gov/dpu">http://www.mass.gov/dpu</a>. The email must also include the name, title, and telephone number of a person to contact in the event of questions about the filing. To the extent a person or entity

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wishes to submit comments in accordance with this Notice, electronic submission, as detailed above, is sufficient.
