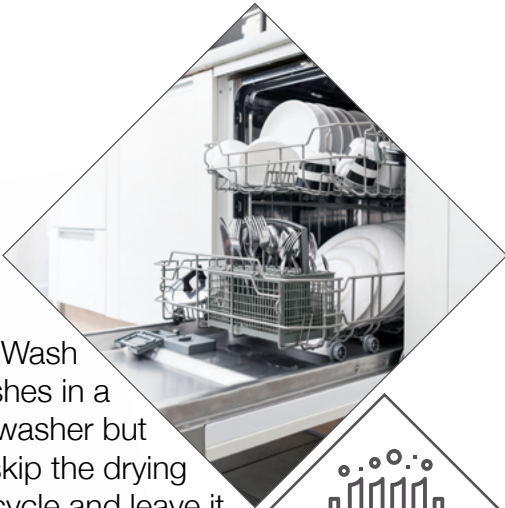

Vegetation, solar screens and awnings can be used to prevent the sun from making your home too hot.

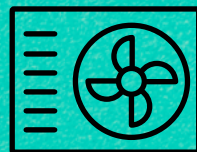

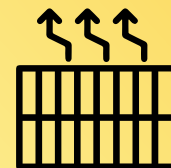

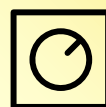


Repairing even small leaks saves gallons of water and dollars each month.
