

# Get started

If you're a new applicant for the Income Eligible Energy Services Program, you'll need to apply in person at your local Community Action Program (CAP) agency.

**Call your local CAP agency, listed on the back of this brochure, for more information.**

### Energy saving services are available if your home is heated with:

- Gas
- Electricity
- Oil
- Propane
- Wood

### You can qualify as:

- A homeowner
- A renter
- The landlord of a 1- to 4-unit building in which at least half of the residents meet income eligibility requirements

# Easy energy saving tips



Close shades and drapes at night to keep heat in during the winter.



Replace old-fashioned incandescent light bulbs with LED bulbs.



Use pot lids when cooking on the stove; food will cook faster.



Run the dishwasher only when it's full.



Turn off computers, monitors, stereos, radios, and TVs when not in use.



Set thermostats to 78° in summer, 68° in winter.

# Discover No-Cost Home Energy Improvements

**See if you qualify for our Income Eligible Energy Services Program.**



National Grid is offering these services in partnership with the Massachusetts Association for Community Action (MASSCAP) and Low-Income Energy Affordability Network (LEAN).

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Our **Income Eligible Energy Services Program** is designed to help make sure you can enjoy a more energy-efficient home that's healthier, more comfortable, and more affordable for you and your family.

## How the program works

Once you qualify, your local **Community Action Program (CAP)** agency will call to arrange a time when an **Energy Specialist** can visit your home to complete a **no-cost energy assessment**.

The Energy Specialist will look inside and out, from attic to basement, to find places where you can save energy and money.

**You may also qualify for no-cost energy saving improvements, such as:**

-  A no-cost replacement of your heating system
-  A no-cost replacement refrigerator, freezer, clothes washer, dehumidifier, and/or window A/C unit if your current appliance is inefficient
-  No-cost attic and wall insulation, weather-stripping, and air sealing of leaks
-  No-cost installation of energy-efficient lighting and water saving devices

## Does my household qualify for no-cost energy efficiency services?

Use the chart below to see if your household meets the income requirement for the **Income Eligible Energy Services Program** as well as other energy services, such as **Fuel Assistance** and **discount rates**.
